Our most successful project to date is <u>ClockTHREE</u>, a clock that tells time in written language. It was derived from <u>Doug Jackson's Word Clock</u> and <u>Evil Mad Science's Peggy 2</u>. Because we are an all-volunteer organization, we have accumulated some funds that we would like to use to support the most innovative ideas in open source hardware development.

WyoLum's mission is to "Promote Open Source Electronics". To that end, we are announcing two \$1000 (USD) "INNOVATION GRANTS" to be awarded to the most qualified applicants. Entries will be evaluated on:

- Innovation
- Originality
- Technical feasibility
- Commercial viability
- Planned use of funds
- Timeline (Projects with goals that can be achieved within six months after the grant is awarded will score more favorably.)

Qualifying projects will be 100% open source (hardware and software) from development through production. WyoLum team members will be available for advice and assistance throughout your project, so if you have a killer idea, but are unsure how to fabricate a PCB or to program a micro controller, or design an enclosure, don't let that stop you from submitting your idea. If we can't immediately assist you, we will learn it together.
